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Online Learning Studio

All courses are hosted on an easy to use, free for users, online virtual studio. This gives learners access to their own virtual studio, with all of the course resources and tools therein; a space where they can work through the course modules and activities at their own pace. They can also upload their work within the virtual studio and receive feedback/ grades (as well as encouragement and support).

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Course Details:

Each course has 6 modules, each module covers a different topic.

Option 3) Honours/Award Level
